

Camper Eligibility Checklist:

- Prospective Camper is age 6-17.
- Prospective Camper experienced the human death of someone significant/close to them
 - ➡ The death occurred within the last 4 years AND no less than 3 months before the start of camp.
- Prospective Camper can recall memories of time and/or activities, they spent with their person who died.
- A guardian of the camper is willing and able to participate in their own session during the camp experience and remain present at the campsite for the duration of the camp day.

Process:

- Completion of a Camp Erin Application found on our website
- A review of Prospective Camper's written application
 - Applications are reviewed on a first come first serve basis
- A phone screening
 - It may take up to 3 weeks before a phone screening
- A Camper Pre-camp appointment*
****Acceptance to camp is contingent upon completion of the Camper & Family Pre-Camp appointment***
